# RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GRAND HAVEN MASTER ASSOCIATION, INC. REGARDING WASTE DISPOSAL

Be it resolved that by the Board of Directors of the Grand Haven Master Association Inc. that the following rules are adopted and will be added to the official records of the Association

In order to maintain the attractiveness and curb appeal of our community, the following time frames, procedures and fining process has been established in regard to residential waste disposal.

## YARD WASTE:

Currently, yard waste is collected each Wednesday throughout our community. It does not have to be bundled but must be of the size that can be lifted by an individual. Excessive amounts of yard trash or yard trash generated by landscape contractors will not be picked up by the City and must be removed by the owner or the owner's contractor.

Yard trash must not be placed at the curb earlier than the day prior to collection by the City. If yard trash is generated prior to Tuesday, it must be stored out of sight at the side of the residence and brought to the curb at the appropriate time, or it must be immediately removed by the owner or the owner's contractor.

### HOUSEHOLD WASTE:

Currently, household waste is collected each Monday and Thursday throughout our community. It may not be placed at the curb earlier than one day prior to collection by the City. It is most strongly recommended that any plastic bags containing household waste NOT be placed at the curb until the day of collection. This will minimize the possibility of nocturnal animals opening the bags and spreading the contents. The City will begin household waste pickup at 6:00am and all trash must be either bagged or in an appropriate garbage container. Bulk trash is picked up the second garbage day each week (Thursday). Please contact the City to schedule the pick-up of any large items. Bulk trash and large items must not be placed at the curb earlier than one day prior to collection by the City.

### RECYCLING:

Currently, recycling is collected each Monday or Thursday throughout our community. Pickup is based on the resident's address and includes items such as paper, plastic, glass, cardboard, etc.

Recycling containers must not be placed at the curb earlier than one day prior to collection by the City.

# **HAZARDOUS WASTE:**

Flagler County has a FREE hazardous waste facility at 1700 S Old Kings Rd (1.5 miles south of SR100). Hazardous materials include but are not limited to paint, batteries, used oil, pool chemicals, pesticides and household cleaners.

This resolution was passed and duly adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Grand Haven Master Association on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2024.
